**MONDAY 11<sup>TH</sup> JANUARY – 10am – 12pm**

Topic – Leaving Your Mark

Early humans left marks and paintings in caves, rocks and trees. Some people today spray fences and walls. Children will hear stories of how and why humans leave their mark on things and then create their own unique mark to be painted on plaster of paris.

**TUESDAY 12<sup>TH</sup> JANUARY – 10am - 12pm**

Topic – Defeating Giants

Topic – Grow Your Own Garden

Children need to come prepared to get their hands dirty as we explore how to care for garden plants. They will then create their own small garden to take home and nurture.

**WEDNESDAY 20<sup>th</sup> JANUARY 10am to 12pm**

Topic – How Do You Build Up Courage

Children will hear the story of how Daniel was placed in a lions den because he would not give in to pressure from others. Through games and craft activities children will explore how they can build up their own courage.

**THURSDAY 21<sup>st</sup> JANUARY – 2pm to 4pm**

Topic – Bewitching Bats

Children will learn about the bat – is it a mammal or a bird? They will hear the story of Why Bat Has No Friends and make various crafts – such as bat mask or bat mobile.

**FRIDAY 22nd JANUARY – 10am to 12.30pm**

Theme – Sharing your Creative side

Our last day will be the opportunity for the children to create something to present to their parents/caregivers. This could be a painting, drawing, clay mould, story, poem, play, music.
