How good are you at waiting?

Psalm 27:14 says: "wait on the Lord, be of good courage and He shall strengthen your heart."

How many times were you told to: 'count to 10' before speaking impulsively or rashly? Waiting before speaking can often calm our emotions. The same can be said of impulse buying—wait 10 days then decide if it is something you only want or something you really need. Today's world is one of 'hurry-up' which places pressure on us all.
