What to Give Up for Lent?

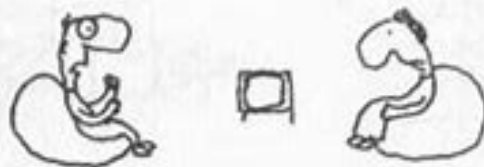
Give up complaining

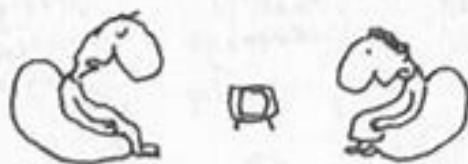
