
Christmas Day Service. Don't Miss **Iesus' Second Advent.**

John 14:3 "And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be with me that you also may be where I am."

Matthew 24:44 "So you also must be ready, because the Son of Man will come at an hour when you do not expect Him."

The Bible talks about Christ's second coming over 10 times more than His first coming. So, we really have no excuse to get caught off-guard.

Have you done any soul-searching; any planning or do you leave everything to the last minute? Is there any expectation - are you looking forward to seeing Jesus?

If you are not ready - you cannot put off getting saved any longer, or you will miss the glory of Christ's return.

Salvation came when Jesus died on the cross.

Salvation was confirmed when Jesus rose from the dead.

Salvation is completed when Jesus returns.

The question is not - did Jesus bring salvation because the answer to that is "yes." It is confirmed historical truth.
